

Stool Collection kit

[Intended Use]

The stool collection kit is intended for human stool sample collection, transportation, and storage.

[Principle of Procedure]

The stool preservation solution can maintain the genetic integrity of DNA of the host and microorganisms in the fecal sample at 2-40°C, effectively preventing degradation and ensuring accurate test results.

[Reagents Provided]

Stool collection tube with DNA preservation solution and stool collector.


[Storage and Handling]

Store at 2-40°C. Do not freeze.

Do not use product after the expiration date.

[Instructions For Use]

- 1. Unfold the wings of the stool collection box and place it on the toilet. If using a seated toilet, cover the inner lid to fix it. For a squat toilet, unfold the wings and place it directly in the toilet, defecating into the collection box (Figure 1).
- 2. Remove the stool collection tube and place it upright on the sponge base.
- 3. Withdraw the syringe plunger to the fixed position (Figure 2), press down and collect the stool sample (Figure 3).
- 4. Place the collected stool sample into the collection tube (Figure 4).
- 5. Screw the lid tightly to ensure no leakage, and shake the tube to mix the fecal sample with the preservation solution thoroughly (Figure 5).







[Specimen Collection and Preparation for Analysis]

- 1. Collect before colorectal examination or colorectal treatment/surgery.
- 2. Collect stool sample free of urine or toilet water.
- 3. Avoid watery stool.
- 4. Store collected samples at 2-40°C for up to 5 days.

For long-term storage, keep at -20°C ± 8°C for no more than 12 months.

[Limitations]

- 1. Do not use watery fecal samples; if encountered, recollect the sample.
- 2. Use the provided "fecal collection box" for defecation sampling, sampling immediately after defecation to avoid feces contact with urine and toilet water.
- 3. This product is for single use only and cannot be reused.

[Warnings and Precautions]

- 1. For research use only.
- 2. Confirm the product is within its shelf life before collecting samples; do not use expired products.
- 3. Before collection, correctly fill out the name and collection date on the preservation tube, ensuring clear and accurate writing.
- 4. After collection, ensure the stool collection tube is leak-proof before placing it back in the packaging for transportation and storage.
- 5. The stool sample should be immersed in the preservation solution.
- 6. The preservation solution can irritate skin and mucous membranes; rinse with plenty of water if contact occurs and seek medical advice if discomfort persists.
- 7. Keep the product out of reach of children; if ingested, drink plenty of water to induce vomiting and seek medical attention immediately.
- 8. Wear a disposable mask and gloves before collecting fecal samples.
- 9. Handle samples carefully to avoid liquid spills; tighten the lid after sampling to prevent leakage and environmental contamination.
- 10. Dispose of remaining samples and consumables properly to avoid pollution after sample collection.
